He also advises on the legal implications of AI use, including in relation to data privacy, professional standards, regulatory compliance and liability for automated decision-making. Beyond advisory work, he presents regularly to legal audiences on the practical uses and risks of AI and is a member of the Victorian Bar's AI Steering Committee.

Prior to joining the Bar, Edward spent almost a decade working on cross-border mergers and acquisitions, complex corporate tax advice, and policy development. He has held roles at Greenwoods & Herbert Smith Freehills, the Commonwealth Treasury, the ATO and Big4 accounting firms.

Edward holds a law degree with first class honours from Monash University, where he also completed an honours thesis on the income tax general anti-avoidance rule. He also holds a Master of Taxation degree from Melbourne University (H2A), a Bachelor of Arts and a Diploma of Languages (German).
